

Rushcliffe weekend GP service for urgent care

Rushcliffe patients who need to see a GP for urgent health care needs at the weekend can now benefit from a new pilot service.

The Rushcliffe urgent care service is operating out of Gamston Medical Centre, staffed by GPs, nurses and receptionists from across the 12 GP practices in Rushcliffe.

The pilot service will run until the end of September initially.

Who is the service for?

Rushcliffe patients with urgent healthcare needs that cannot wait until Monday morning.

How can patients access the service?

Patients must call NHS 111 and speak to a health care professional who will decide if they need to see a GP that same day. Patients will then be given an appointment with the Rushcliffe urgent care service.

Do patients need an appointment?

Yes. **Patients must have an appointment** before arriving at Gamston Medical Centre. The service cannot accommodate walk in patients.

When does the service operate?

Saturday and Sunday mornings, 8:30am – 12:30pm.
